

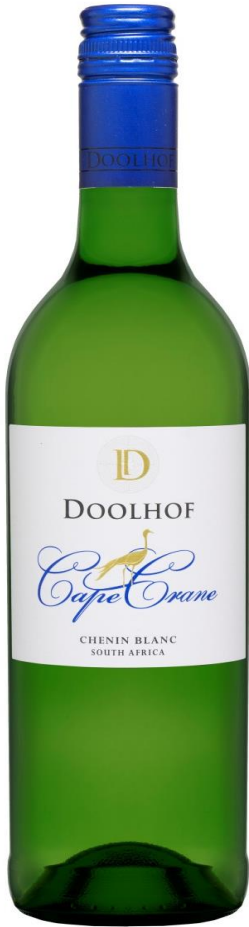

Cape Crane 2019

A lovely and light Chenin Blanc made for every day enjoyment, bursting with fruit characters.



Tasting Notes:

Light straw in colour, with a green tint, the nose is complex and fresh with Cape gooseberry, citrus and a touch of ripe melon. The palate crisp and refreshing, well balanced with a lingering zesty finish.

Winemaker's Notes:

Handpicked in the early morning, with grapes received at the cellar, still cool, and in great condition. The grapes were crushed and destemmed and cold settled for two days. The clear juice was racked and fermentation was induced with commercial yeast. Fermentation lasted 21 days, with fermenting temperatures at around 13° Celsius.

Serving Suggestion:

Serve with fresh mussels, fish or Cape rock lobster in lemon butter, excellent with poultry, and a great companion to any picnic.
